Bard College at Simon's Rock invites applications for an adjunct position in Computer Science for the Fall 2016 semester. Teaching responsibilities will consist of 1 or 2 classes depending on final enrollment numbers and the interest of the applicant. One of the courses will be our Introduction to Computer Science course, which is focused on Python programming. Requirements are flexible, although a Ph.D. (or ABD status) in Computer Science or related field by time of appointment is desirable, as is previous experience teaching undergraduate Computer Science courses. An ability to promote female participation in Computer Science is also an asset.

Simon's Rock is small liberal arts college in Massachusetts's beautiful Berkshire county with young motivated students. We have a strong history of undergraduate research and student-led projects in the Science division, and nearly 80% of our students continue on to graduate school. Enrollment in our Computer Science program has tripled over the past three years, and a motivated applicant will find many additional ways to aide in this growth if they wish to do so.

Applicants should submit a Cover Letter, CV, Teaching Statement, Research Statement (optional), and contact information for three References to MathJobs.
